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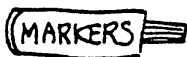

Subject: The Transfiguration

basic supplies:



- materials:
- shiny white fabric
 - plain white or beige or tan fabric (Synthetic works best)
 - fabric crayons (most art & craft stores)
 - iron
 - sewing machine (for teacher)

teacher preparation:

- sew simple puppets for each child, one plain on one side & shiny white on the other
- cut paper the same shape
- set up a place to iron
- practice with crayons on a scrap of fabric

procedure:

- each child gets 2 pieces of paper & 1 puppet
- have them color brightly on the paper, one back view of a person, one front view
- iron the pictures on the puppet
- Give each child a character to be (if you have the right number of children)
- Act out the story, perhaps letting them read or recite, turning the LORD puppet over to change from plain to shiny



notes: turn on the iron a few minutes ahead of time
You could have 2 children be the LORD, one before & one after transfiguration
