basic supplies:    (MARKERS)  PAPER  PAINT

### materials:

- white or yellow garbage bags } or buy inexpensive ready-made kites
- or tissue paper
- dowels, tape
- kite string
- \* • red, yellow, orange, pink permanent markers
- scissors, exacto knives
- red fabric scraps

### teacher preparation:

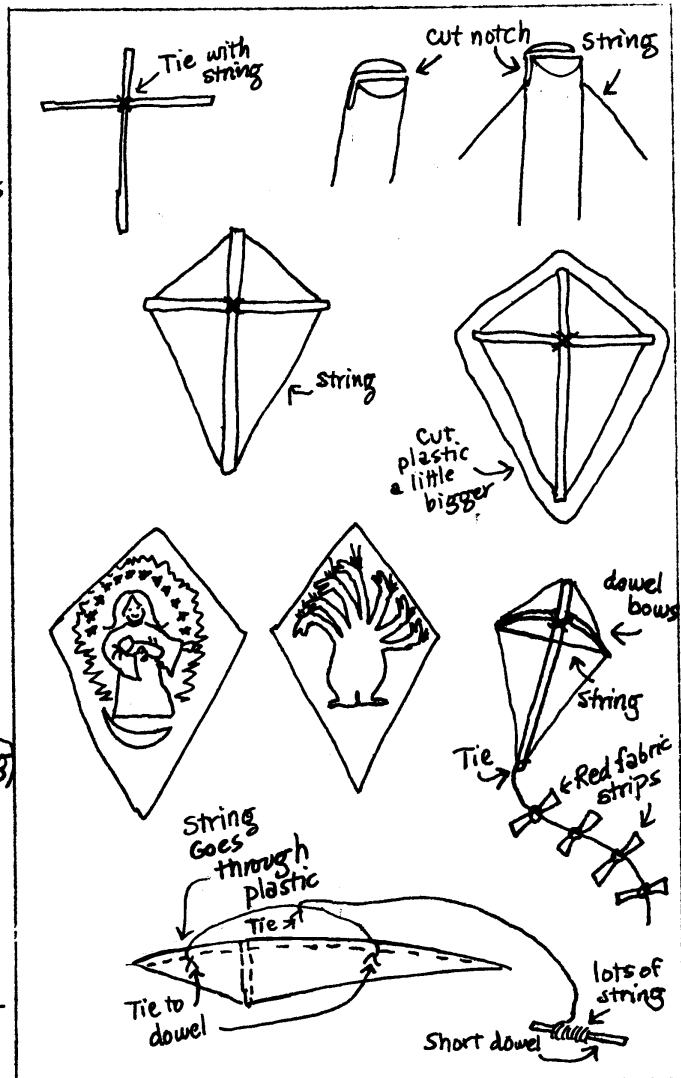
- cut dowels to 3 lengths: 36", 27", 6"
- cut long pieces of string for each child, 20' to 50' long (you could wrap on 6" dowels for them, or let them do it)

### procedure:

To Make Kite:

- firmly tie a long and medium dowel together (wrap short stick with lots of string)
- cut notches in ends of dowels
- firmly tie string connecting 4 ends, going through notches
- cut plastic garbage bag open, lay flat, and cut out a piece for the kite 1"-2" bigger than string border
- tape on to string after drawing the woman clothed with the sun on one side and the dragon on the other
- tie a string between side notches and bow the dowel by tying tightly
- poke holes in plastic and tie a string about 8" from top and 12" from bottom (to dowel) ~ tie string on short dowel to this piece of string
- make dragon's tail by tying red fabric strips to a string and tie string to kite bottom

\*if using tissue, they don't need to be permanent
