The Word in Heaven Shines Like the Sun

In the temples of heaven, the Word itself shines before the eyes of the angels like a great star, and sometimes like a sun. And from the bright radiance round about the Word, beautiful rainbows are seen. (see True Christian Religion 209)

Make a picture of the Word in heaven, shining like a great star or like the sun.

Suggested Materials:

heavy paper (construction paper, cover stock, card stock or poster board) silver **or** gold foil wrapping paper, glitter, metallic pen, or colored pencils fine point colored markers, colored pencils, or gel pens *optional*: templates for the sun or great star glue scissors pencil

Procedure:

- 1. Use the heavy paper to as the background for your picture.
- 2. Choose whether you want to show the Word shining like a star or the sun before the eyes of the angels. Then make a picture of the open Word with the outline of a star or rays of the sun behind it.
- 3. To show the Word shining like a star, use silver paper, glitter, metallic pen, or colored pencils to make the star behind the Word.
- 4. To show the Word shining like the sun, use gold paper, glitter, metallic pen, or colored pencils to make the rays of the sun behind the Word.
- 5. The open Word should also be beautiful, with pages touched with silver or gold depending on whether you are showing the Word shining like a star (pages with silver) or shining like the sun (pages with gold).
- 6. *Optional Rainbows*: If desired, use the colored pencils, markers, or gel pens to make beautiful rainbows near the Word. You could make several rainbows around it or make one full (circular rainbow) surrounding the Word.
