basic supplies:



materials: old National Geographics

(or other pretty pictures)

- wooden plaques (or slices of a log)*
- fancy markers (gold, silver, calligraphy are great but simple thin markers will do)
- glue, white paper, scissors
- matches, candles
- varnish, brushes, smocks, newspaper, thinner

teacher preparation:

- set up area (well ventilated) for varnishing
- find inspiring verses from Psalm and have ideas for pictures to go with them
- have Bibles or Words for them to look through

Procedure:

- children pick a verse they like from the Psalm and find a picture that illustrates it (e.g. 4 ~ bird; 6 ~ night; 11 ~ mother and baby; 19 ~ mountain etc)
- write in nicest writing on white paper, the quote they have chosen
- being careful not to burn too much, burn edges of picture and quote in candle flame
- glue to plaque
- varnish and let dry several days



notes:

- any wood pieces would be alright
 - dampen center of paper to prevent burning before printing.
