

Who Can See the Beauty of the Word?

In the spiritual world, the Word shines before the eyes of the angels like a great star and sometimes like a sun. And from the bright radiance round about it there are beautiful rainbows (True Christian Religion 209).

Procedure

1. Have each child use one circle to show how the Word looks to an angel seeing it in a temple in heaven. It will appear like a star or a sun and may have beautiful rainbows around it.
2. Each child should use the other circle to show how the Word looks to an evil spirit. It should be black because evil spirits don't see the beautiful light of the Lord's Word.
3. Cut out both circles and fasten them together with a pencil or craft stick between the circles to make a handle. (See diagram below right.)
4. Now talk about the Word in heaven. Ask the children to show you what the Word looks like to someone who loves the Lord? What does it look like to a bad person?
