## Woman Clothed with the Sun Stained Glass Window

Now a great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a garland of twelve stars.

(Revelation 12:1)

## Suggested Materials:

window design printed on white paper, translucent paper (such as tracing paper), or on clear sheet (such as an overhead transparency)


colored markers, colored pencils, or wax crayons

optional: salad oil and brush or paper towel

optional: black construction paper for making a frame

## Procedure for Translucent (tracing) or Regular Paper:

- 1. Use colored markers, pencils, oil pastels, or wax crayons to color the design.
- 2. Remember that the woman is clothed with the sun and standing on the moon, so use bright, fiery colors such as gold, yellow, orange, and white.
- 3. If you are using regular white paper, you may want to brush it (the colored side) lightly with salad oil after coloring. This will make it somewhat translucent so that it looks like a stained glass window.
- 4. Optional Frame: To make a black frame for the window
  - a. fold the black construction paper in half
  - b. use a ruler and pencil to make a line about 1 inch from all edges except the fold
  - c. cut along the lines so that you have cut a large rectangle out of the full page
  - d. unfold the paper, center the design within the frame, and then tape into place



5. Display in a sunny window so that the light can shine through the beautiful picture.

## **Procedure for Coloring Design Printed on Clear Sheet** (overhead transparency)

- 1. Use colored markers to color the design. (You may need to use a special kind of markers such as those made for overhead transparencies or permanent markers.)
- 2. Remember that the woman is clothed with the sun and standing on the moon, so use bright, fiery colors such as gold, yellow, orange, and white.
- 3. After coloring, display in a sunny window so that the light can shine through the beautiful picture.
- 4. If desired, make a frame according to the directions above.

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
