## Invisible Ink

Did you know that you can make invisible ink with lemon juice or orange juice?

- Pour the juice into a small jar or bowl. Then dip a cotton swab, fine paintbrush, or toothpick into the juice and write on a blank piece of paper. The words will be visible while the ink is drying, but then disappear.
- ◆ To make the writing appear, hold the paper over a 150-watt light bulb. (Be very careful not to touch the light bulb with your hand or the paper.) The heat of the light bulb will turn the ink brown, so that the message can easily be read.
- ◆ Another way to see the "invisible ink" is to hold the paper up to the light.
- ◆ Notice that it takes heat or light to make the ink visible. And who gives us the sun as a source of heat and light? The Lord! He also gives us the spiritual light that allows us to see what is true.
