basic supplies:



materials: toothpicks, smocks

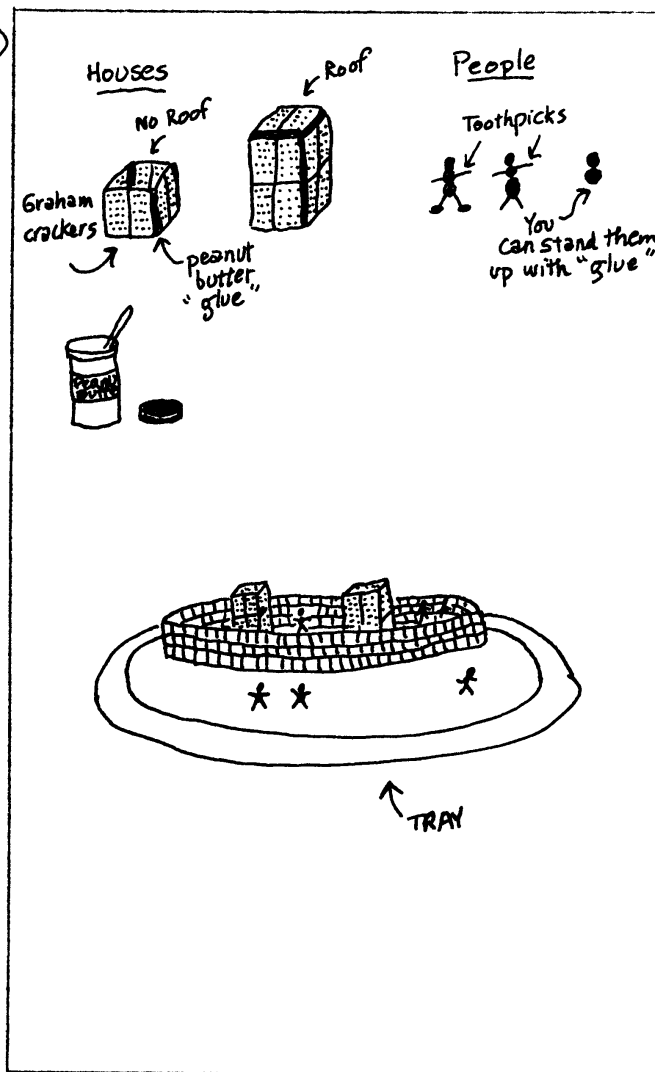
- sugar cubes (or croutons, or little cookies)
- gum drops or raisins or grapes
- graham crackers (or saltines)
- peanut butter, or frosting or "glue" made of flour or confectioner's sugar and water
- large tray, butter knives or plastic knives

teacher preparation:

- make "glue" if necessary, and try it out
- put it in little bowls with knives

procedure:

- make the city Jerusalem with graham crackers and whatever glue, peanut butter etc. you are using
- make the wall around with sugar cubes and "glue"
- make people by breaking toothpicks and sticking gum drops or raisins on them
- put people in and around the walled city
