basic supplies:



materials: smocks, newspapers

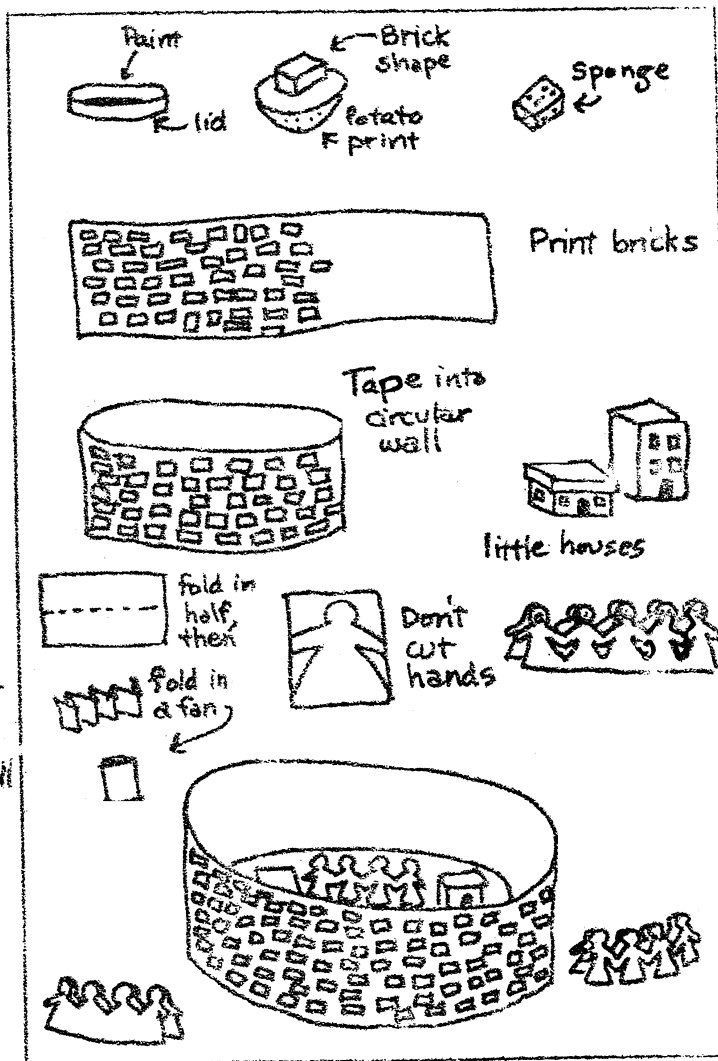
- grey paper (long, or tape together)
- potatoes or sponges
- black, brown & grey paint
- lots of little boxes
- paper, scissors, markers, tape
- lids of jars

teacher preparation:

- set up a place for the city and wall ~ perhaps a sandbox, or on a brown towel, or just a table
- put a little paint in the lids
- cut potatoes or sponges into brick shapes for printing

procedure: spread newspapers

- print bricks all over the grey paper with potatoes or sponges and paint (dip in lids) tape into a circular wall
- make boxes into little buildings, by cutting doors, painting or drawing windows, put inside wall
- make paper people by folding paper and cutting as illustrated
- make faces and put some inside, some outside the wall (the people inside have sad faces)
